1. Take the Present Age/Future Age diagram on page 53 and use it to discuss [the significance to our lives](#) of the two lines overlapping—encapsulating the 'Interim, where Two Ages Co-exist.'

3. If Jesus' death resolved our sins, why was Jesus [resurrected](#)? Where is Jesus now? What are the implications of Jesus' resurrection [for people living now](#)?
4. Your neighbour, who knows that you are a card carrying, born again Christian and is slightly wary of what you may say and do, confides in you that he has a really bad earache. How would you explain to him—in [2 minutes](#)—that if you prayed for him the kingdom of God could break through and he would be healed? (Or not!)
